Talk it Over

Read Colossians 1:6 (NLT)

Leader Instructions: Invite others in the group to read the Bible verses during your weekly study using their participant's guide or Bible.

Read Colossians 2:6-10 (NLT)

Leader Instructions: Invite others in the group to read the Bible verses during your weekly study using their participant's guide or Bible.

Q5: Using the imagery of this text, what is keeping you rooted in Jesus currently? What spiritual practice or pattern in your life is helping you stay most connected to Jesus? (For example: A growth group, weekly worship service, Bible reading and prayer, silence, etc.)

James mentioned the Kingdom of God waves we have been making during the past year through our

Cannonball Generosity Initiative. United in one mission, we are creating ripples of positive impact throughout our communities by helping people find and follow Jesus. Our God-sized dreams are being fulfilled, but as James mentioned, there are spiritual forces at work around us working against our unity with God and one another.

Q6: Based on Colossians 2:6-10, what are these spiritual forces and how have such forces influenced our everyday lives?

Q7: What are some modern-day "empty philosophies and high-sounding nonsense" that tend to capture your attention or that you've believed in the past?"

The second thing that we heard James highlight from this text is that our unity is rooted in the fact that we are one in Jesus.

Q8: What does the phrase "you also are complete through your union with Christ" mean for you and how does it change the way we interact with God and others?

Q9: How do you remain confident that God loves you unconditionally, even as you are challenged by the "spiritual powers" around you? What areas in your life can we pray for?

Colossians 1:6 NLT

This same Good News that came to you is going out all over the world. It is bearing fruit everywhere by changing lives, just as it changed your lives from the day you first heard and understood the truth about God's wonderful grace.

The section of this verse that is "good news" for me today is
Colossians 2:6-10 NLT And now, just as you accepted Christ Jesus as your Lord, you must continue to follow him. Let your roots grow down into him, and let your lives be built on him.
